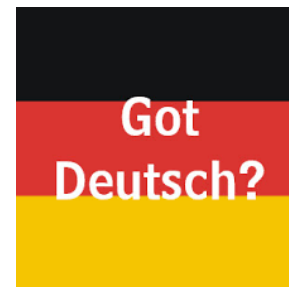
German Language Classes

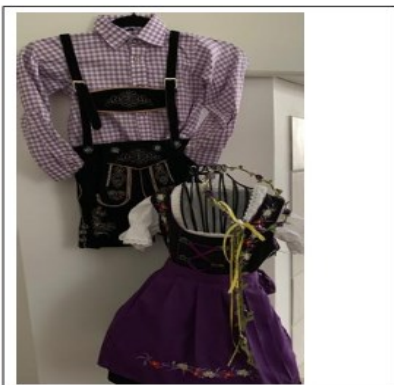
